FITTING FOR ALL LIVESTOCK ENTERED IN FAIR WILL BE BATH/BLOW/BRUSH (ONLY).
Clipping Of Hair Is Permitted and should be done at home before coming to Fair.
However It Is Recommended To Leave ½ Inch Of Hair On The Body.
No Painting Or Gluing Hair Onto Swine.

1. Late Registrations will not be accepted unless arrangements have been made with the office.
2. All Swine must be born on or after January 1st of the current year, be owned and in your possession by June 1st
3. Swine must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) completed within 30 days of check-in.
4. Each exhibitor may enter two Market Swine and all animals must be sold during the Youth Livestock Sale
5. Animals must be tagged and properly registered and must include RFID AND 4-H TAGS numbers.
6. Animal Registrations without the proper RFID on the form, will be denied entry into the barn.
7. If during the fair a RFID tag needs to be reissued the fair will provide one replacement on the day of occurrence. If another replacement is needed the exhibitor will bear the cost of any new RFID tag(s).
8. Market Swine can be barrows and/or gilts, with a minimum weight of 220 pounds; maximum weight 290 pounds.
9. Swine over or under-weight will be denied entry into the barn and will return home.
10. Weigh-ins are the Saturday preceding fair. 8:00 AM to 10:00 AM.
11. All pens will be assigned by the superintendent. If deemed necessary, each exhibitor will be assigned one pen resulting in some cases to 2 pigs in one pen. The exhibitor in such cases will be responsible for a divider if needed. No pens will be moved.

12. ALL issues must be taken to the Superintendent. If the issue cannot be resolved the issue will be taken before the Board of Directors
13. Any Substitute Showman must be approved by the Superintendent and be a current Cambria County 4-H livestock member.
14. During the Market Swine Show the barn is closed to everyone except Show Stewards, Parents and Exhibitors. Only the exhibitor is permitted in the catch pen.
15. **The Fair Reserves The Right To Blood Test Any Animal Suspected Of Non Species Drugs Being Given To An Animal Or Withdraw Date In Question.**
16. **IMPORTANT SALE INFORMATION-** Market animals must be sold during the Youth Livestock Sale.
17. Exhibitors **MUST be on time and are responsible for the movement of the animal to the Sale Ring and back, when scheduled for sale.** Exhibitors may have assistance from family.
18. **No-Show Exhibitors Will Result In The Animal Being Sold Through The Buyback Program.**
19. **Exhibitor MUST take sale paperwork to their buyers** for signature to complete the transaction.
20. Exhibitors may have a parent/sibling/friend present at ringside to hold the animal while this is done.
21. Exhibitors **MUST** care for their market animals through load out on Saturday afternoon. This includes proper feed/water, pen maintenance.
22. ALL SWINE WILL GO TO AN APPROVED DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE PROCESSOR
23. PA Pork Check-Off will deduct an additional .4% off all Swine sold.
24. **All stalls must be cleaned daily** and upon the exit of your animal. It is not the Superintendents responsibility to clean stalls. **Failure to comply will result in premium checks being held.**

SECTION 501 – PUREBRED MARKET SWINE

25. Purebred Market Swine are required to have a Certificate of Registry to show in Purebred class. If no registration is presented to the Fair Office with all other required paperwork by July 15th, swine will be entered in Crossbred division.
26. If there are fewer than 3 animals registered in a class they will show in the class labeled as "Other Purebred".

SECTION 503 – COUNTY BRED MARKET SWINE

Exhibitors are required to fill out the County Bred Verification Form in its entirety.

1. A breeder signature is required either on the registration form or on a signed copy of a sales receipt.
2. Sales receipt must describe the animal as a “Cambria County Bred Market Swine” & have a tag number as a reference.
3. A “Cambria County Bred Market Swine” must meet all the County Bred requirements. The requirements are: the animal must be born from a female that is owned by a Cambria County resident that has taken the responsibility to breed the female and for that female to bear offspring while in their possession in Cambria County and that offspring be raised in Cambria County.
4. The Cambria County Breeder signature, address and phone number is required, e-mail is optional.
5. County Bred Form must accompany the Entry Form.
