Clipping Of Hair Is Not Permitted at Fair and should be done at home before coming
to Fair.**

SPECIES SPECIFIC & BARN RULES FOR 4-H GOATS

1. All Goats must be USDA tagged or USDA tattooed as recognized in an approved USDA Scrapie database.
2. This ID MUST be listed on the CVI, completed within 30 days of check-in on the Health Certificate
3. All Exhibitors Must Provide A Breed Certificate For Any Goat Being Shown As Purebred.
4. **Each Exhibitor Showing Dairy and/or Meat Breeding Goats is Limited to 6 Goats Across The Board, Including The Maximum Of 2 Market Goats**
5. **ADDITIONAL FITTING RULES FOR GOAT:**
 - ◇ The use of Paint or Polish (spray or liquid) will not be permitted.
 - ◇ A Light Touch Up Of A Brush May Be Used Preceding And During The Show.
 - ◇ All fitting and preparation must be done in an ethical manner.
6. The exhibitor is responsible for completing the grooming and fitting of their project animal. Immediate Family Members or their Cambria County 4H leaders may assist by direction only. No unethical practices will be tolerated, before, during or after the show i.e. slapping/hitting, suspending off sheering stands, ice or frozen blankets, show shake drenching, injections of any substance orally or rectally in the body (without prior authorization of the Fair's Veterinarian and Barn Superintendent) or suspending feet off the ground or pronged collars.
7. Fitting Stands are permitted, however animals must not be left unattended.

8. ALL Washing and Show Preparation will take place in the Sheep-Goat Barn Wash Pen, Fitting Pen or Lean-To side Arena **ONLY. The New Beef Wash Rack Is Not To Be Used. (Violators Will Be Dismissed From The Contest).** If necessary, the old wash area inside the Beef Barn can be used **with** Superintendent permission and monitoring.
9. **ALL GOATS MUST BE OFF THE STANDS BY 4 PM.**
10. Goat Stands/Show Boxes **Must** be kept in the storage area designated by the Barn Superintendent.
11. **Stands/Boxes are permitted in the Main Aisle the Evening Prior and the Day of the Show.** Tools must be stored promptly after the Show.
12. Pronged Show Halters or Collars are not permitted. **THERE WILL BE NO WARNING FOR THIS RULE. - VIOLATORS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**
13. Exhibitors may not show Dairy and/or Meat Breeding Goats in more than one County Fair.
14. Minimum Weight is 60 pounds, maximum weight is 125 pounds.
15. Decorations, awards or ribbons must be put on the back wall or attached to the steel wire where supplied. Decorations, awards or ribbons. may not be put of the stall or doors.
16. When in the Show Ring, ALL 4 Hooves of the animal **MUST** be on the ground when displaying the animal for judging. Exhibitors will be reminded of this rule prior to the show. Show Stewards will monitor this and any violators will be disqualified. The eligibility to sell the animal will be at the discretion of the Youth Livestock Sale Committee.
17. Market and Meat Breeding Goats must be off their Show Stands and ready to show by the time Dairy Showmanship ends.
18. **Exhibitors Are Not Permitted To Be Coached In The Show Ring By Any Person Or Persons In Attendance.**

SECTION 601 – MARKET GOATS**

1. **IMPORTANT SALE INFORMATION** - Market animals may be sold during the Youth Livestock Sale.
2. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion animals **MUST** be sold at the sale.
3. Exhibitors **MUST be on time and present in the sale ring when their animal is scheduled for sale.** Those that are not, will be sold through the BuyBack program.
4. **Exhibitors MUST take sale paperwork to their buyers** for signature to complete the transaction.
5. Families **MUST** have a parent/sibling/friend present at ringside to hold the animal while the exhibitor runs the paperwork.
6. **Exhibitors MUST care for their Market Animals through load out on Saturday afternoon.** This includes proper feed/water, pen maintenance and washing any fitting products off the animals.
7. **NEW FOR 2026 - Market Goats Must Be Born On Or After January 1 Of The Current Year And Be Owned And In Your Possession By June 1st.**

SECTION 602 – COUNTYBRED MARKET GOATS

1. Exhibitors showing in the County Bred Market Class, are required to fill out the registration form in its entirety.
2. A breeder signature is required either on the registration form or on a signed copy of a sales receipt.
3. Sales receipt must describe the animal as a “Cambria County Bred Market Goat” and have a tag number as a reference.
4. A “Cambria County Bred Market Goat” must meet all the County Bred requirements. The Requirements Are:
 - ◇ The animal must be born from a female that is owned by a Cambria County resident that has taken the responsibility to breed the female and for that female to bear offspring while in their possession in Cambria County
 - ◇ That offspring is raised in Cambria County.
5. Cambria County Breeder signature, address, phone number is required, e-mail is optional.
6. The County Bred Form must be turned in with Entry Form.

COUNTY BRED SHOW - the top 2 Placed Goats in the Market Classes will return for the County Bred Show.

Grand Champion and Reserve Champion in the Market Show are not eligible to enter.
