

PLEASE REFER TO THE FRONT OF THIS BOOK FOR GENERAL RULES/REGULATIONS AND INFORMATION CONCERNING EXHIBITING AT FAIR.

SPECIES & BARN SPECIFIC RULES FOR EQUINE The American Legion County Fair Requires A Coggins Test, Rabies Certificate and A C.V.I. Accompany Each Horse Entering the Fairgrounds.

- Pee Wee: Riders ages 2-4 years of age as of September 1st of the current year.
 Lead line with an adult 18 years or over is Required.
 Pee Wee riders may only ride on Miniature or Pony 13.2 hands or smaller.
- Youth Rider: Riders ages 5-10 years as if September 1st of the current year.
 A Youth Rider may ride any size equine.
- Junior Rider: Riders ages 11-17 years as if September 1st of the current year.
 A Junior Rider may ride any size equine.
- Adult Rider: Riders aged 18 years and over.




When on Equine, Riders 17 and under must always wear hard hats in or out of the ring.

- 1. Each exhibitor is responsible for lanyard registrations. Please Refer to Page ??
- 2. Any/All issues must be taken to the Superintendent who will try to resolve the issue. If the Superintendent cannot settle the issue, it will then be taken before the Board of Directors.
- 3. 1 Exhibitor Per Horse Per Entry Form. Each Horse Must Be On It's Own Entry Form.

4. 1 Rider 1 Horse. Substitutions Will Not Be Accepted Without Prior Authorization From Superintendent.

- 5. Equine must be shown in 2 or more Performance Classes
- 6. All Ponies are required to have a height card and will be measured at check in. Please see the superintendent.
- All Equine must have A Breed Card including the following information: Owner/Rider Name and Phone 7. Number The Name and Phone Number of the Veterinarian The information will be noted at check in and the card must be put on display at the stall for the week of fair.
- 8. All Horses And Mini's must have and present Registered Paperwork or will be shown in Grade Classes.
- 9. If entry numbers do not warrant all breeds classes, classes may be combined or if insufficient entries in classes occur the result may be the elimination of classes.
- 10. Back Tags must be displayed on Exhibitors back or they will not be judged.
- 11. Premiums are paid to the Back Tag Number of each exhibitor not the horse. Back Tags may not be switched between riders.
- 12. There will be no Tack Stalls. The only exception is Draft Horses
- 13. Horse's heads cannot hang into the aisle in any way. Stalls should have wire installed at the back of the stall to prevent this issue.
- 14. Exhibitors Must be ready with their horses at least 15 minutes before the time appointed in the Premium Book. Performance classes will be called by number. After the 3rd call you will be excused.
- 15. Draft Horses Hitched to a Cart or other Vehicle must have someone lead them to and from the Arena. Horses may be Pure Bred or Grade but must have been shown in the appropriate preceding individual class.
- 16. All hitches will be judged, Must remain for the duration of the Fair. ONLY Equine brought in for the Draft Horse Pull are the exception.
- 17. Equine are Not Permitted at Campers or Trailers within the Gates. Equine cannot be tied to the fence. Please See The Map For Designated Horse Travel Areas
- 18. The show committee reserves the right to expel any person from the grounds without refund of entry fees for cruelty to animals and un-sportsman like behavior.
- 19. Any equine that poses a hazard or disruption for a class will be excused
- Striking an Equine above the shoulders will not be 20. tolerated and will result in expulsion from Fairgrounds and loss of all premiums.
- Any visibly lame horse will be withdrawn from the class 21. and may not be shown for the remainder of the day.
- 22. Exhibitors must wear hard sole boots with a heel and a long-sleeved shirt tucked in. No other attire will be permitted.



Designated Travel to the Arena

- 23. English and Western must have the appropriate attire and tack suited for these classes.
- Exhibitors lacking appropriate care of their horse during the week of fair will be at risk of losing premi-24. ums and the opportunity to enter fair the following year.
- 25. All Equine must be checked out with the Barn Superintendent upon leaving the Fairgrounds.
