FITTING FOR ALL LIVESTOCK ENTERED IN FAIR WILL BE BATH/BLOW/BRUSH (ONLY). Clipping Of Hair is Not Permitted at Fair and should be done at home before coming to Fair.

- 1. Late Registrations will not be accepted unless arrangements have been made with the office.
- 2. All goats must be USDA tagged or USDA tattooed as recognized in an approved USDA Scrapie database.
- 3. This identification must be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) completed within 30- days of check-in the health certificate.
- 4. Goats will be Does and Wethers.
- 5. Horns are permitted.
- 6. Exhibitors Must Produce A Breed Certificate or Any oat Being Shown As Purebred.
- 7. All Grooming And Fitting Must Occur In The Goat Barn No Exceptions.
- 8. A Light Touch Up Consisting Of A Brush May Be Used Preceding And During The Show.
- 9. DUETO SAFETY CONCERNS:
 - Goat Stands/Show Boxes are to be kept in storage areas designated by the barn superintendents.
 - Stands/Boxes are allowed in the main aisle the night prior and the day of the show.
 - ♦ Stands/Boxes must be stored **promptly** after the show.
- 10. All decorations must be put on the back wall or attached to the steel wire where supplied. No decorations, awards or ribbons may be put on the stall or doors for the animal's safety.
- 11. All stalls must be cleaned <u>daily</u> and upon the exit of your animal. Failure to comply will result in premium checks being held.
- 12. Entries will be released from the barn at 7 pm the last Saturday of fair week.
