**ONE FORM PER EXHIBITOR IF ENTERING MORE THAN 1 RABBIT ALL RABBITS MAY BE LISTED ON THE SAME FORM**

**WITHOUT THE PROPER PAPERWORK ANIMALS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO SHOW AT FAIR.**

**GENERAL RULES**

1. Rabbits must be identified by a legible Tattoo in the Left Ear.
2. Identification will be verified upon arrival at Fair.
3. **No Rabbit** showing signs of contagious or infectious disease or open wounds will be admitted into the Rabbit Barn.
4. Each Exhibitor may show 2 Show Rabbits and 1 Pair of Meat Rabbits. The Doe & Litter are considered as 1 ShowRabbit.
5. Feed and water containers are provided by the Rabbit Barn.
6. It is the responsibility of the owner to feed, water, and maintain cleanliness of cages. It is not the responsibility of the Barn superintendent.
7. HAY OR STRAW IS NOT PERMITTED IN THE CAGES.
8. Any and all issues must be taken to the Barn Superintendent. If issues cannot be resolved through the Superintendent, the issues will be taken before the Board of Directors for a resolution.
9. Entries will be released from the Barn beginning at 7:00 pm the last Saturday of Fair.
10. **DURING THE 4-H RABBIT SHOW THE BARN WILL BE CLOSED TO EVERYONE WITH THE EXCEPTION OF RABBIT SHOW STEWARDS, LEADERS AND EXHIBITORS.**

1. Meat Rabbits must be 4-6 pounds each and no more than 12 weeks old at check in day of fair. Market Rabbits may be sold through the Youth Livestock Sale
2. The Grand and Reserve Grand Champions Must be sold through the Sale.
3. All Exhibitors must be present and on time in the Sale Ring when their animal is scheduled for sale. Those not present and on time will have their animals sold through Buyback.
4. Each Exhibitor must take the sale paperwork to their buyer for signatures to complete the transaction.
